Levels: Varsity Boys, Varsity Girls, Frosh-Soph Boys, Frosh-Soph Girls Entry

Location: Carbon Canyon Regional Park, Brea, CA (Lambert Rd., ½ mile east of Valencia Ave.)

Registration: Same-day signups. Cash and credit cards accepted. Registration begins at 6:30 a.m. in the park.

Cost: \$20 per person.

Parking: It's a county regional park, which charges \$5 to park on weekends. Free street parking is available across the street in the nearby residential area.

Awards: \$100 for the top male and female finishers, top 15 male and top 15 female finishers receive medals.

Timing: Computerized, hand-timed results will be posted soon after the run's completion.
